

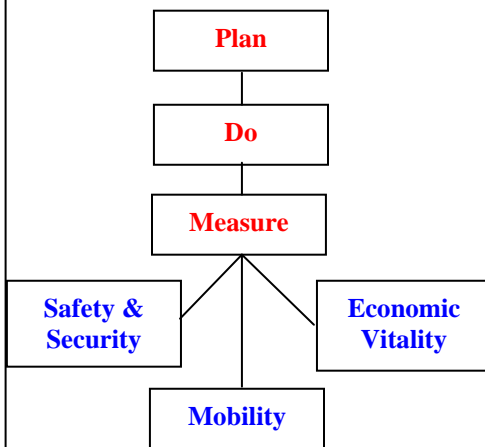


I-95 Corridor Coalition

The I-95 Corridor Coalition announces the formation of two new task forces to address the priorities of our members:

Performance Measures Framework



Performance Measures – This Task Force has two major focus areas:

- To conduct a programmatic assessment of the Coalition’s performance: results and benefits from projects and other work of the Program Track Committees, and
- To review the transportation system performance improvements in the corridor resulting from the Coalition’s collaboration.

Performance measures are the practical way to link the Coalition’s mission and strategies with the results of our work. The measures will be multimodal, reflect the diversity of our members and states, relate to outputs and outcomes of Coalition programs and projects, and be practical and helpful to develop and use.

Safety – This Task Force will serve as a vehicle for disseminating information about best practices and lessons learned from other safety initiatives in the region and to assist members with identifying solutions to their safety needs. The Task Force will support the development of transportation safety-related projects and will assist in the execution of these projects through the program tracks. The Task Force will also look to leverage the resources and expertise of members throughout the 16-state corridor for the purpose of addressing multi-state safety issues identified by our members that impact longer distance travelers.
